

"Tonopah - Bryden M. Bateman, aged forty-eight years, will be buried here tomorrow under the auspices of the Knights of Pythias and the local lodge of Elks, with which he had been associated since his arrival in camp fourteen years ago from Deadwood SD. He was a Captain of Company No. 4, Uniform Rank.

Coming from the Isle of Man, where he was born, Bateman went to the Black Hills and engaged in mining, transferring here when the Tonopah boom was at its height and entered the service of the West End Con. Mining Company, where he remained for two years, changing to an outdoor position with the Tonopah and Goldfield market and later serving as deputy assessor under Sheriff Thomas and his successor, Jack Barrier.

He leaves a widow and child."
