Miner Dies In Tonopah

"Tonopah - Pete Bielich, well known miner of Southern Nevada, died at the Mine Operators Hospital Sunday morning (either 20 Mar or 27 Mar 1935) following an illness of some several weeks. Bielich was seventy-four years of age and a native of Jugoslavia (sic). Coming to this country when a young man, he followed mining at Delmar and Austin for nearly thirty years. He came to Nye county eight years ago and has made his home here since. He was unmarried. Surviving are a brother and two nephews in Jugoslavia, a nephew in California, and a cousin, Mike Bielich, of Elko, formerly of Tonopah, who was here for the funeral."
