

Resident of Tonopah the past 39 years, Mr Bird came to Nye County in 1912 and worked in a meat market at Round Mountain for four years. In 1916 Mr. Bird was married to the former Miss Bessie Turner of San Mateo, CA. The couple married in Tonopah. For the next few years Mr. Bird worked in the Victor and Tonopah - Belmont Mines until 1920 when he moved to Goldfield where he was again employed in a meat market for three years.

Mr. Bird returned to Tonopah in 1925 and was connected with the Mine Workers Mercantile until 1941 when he opened Bird's Grocery, which he operated with his two sons until his death.
