

Pioneer Resident Of Tonopah Dies

TONOPAH, Nev. 4. (Special) — Miss Margaret "Maggie" Blue, one of the better known old-time residents of Tonopah and Nye county, died here this morning after a short illness. Funeral arrangements are pending.

Miss Blue, 81, was a native of Paisley, Scotland, where she was born on September 6, 1872. She came to the United States as a young woman and shortly after the turn of the century moved to Mosby's station in the Ralston desert north of Tonopah.

She became widely known to travelers for the boarding house which was half-way between Tonopah and Manhattan. During World War I she was one of the most active and generous contributors to the Red Cross and shortly after the war she moved to Tonopah, living here since that time.
