At the time of her death Anne was one of the oldest Pioneers in Nevada. She was born at Prince Edward Island, England and died at her daughter Mrs. J.A. Moore's ranch in Smokey Valley. Death was caused by advanced age.

Anne came to Nevada with her husband in 1867, taking up residence at Fish Lake Valley. Later they moved to Tybo where she remained through the mining boom of that town. For more than 20 years Mrs. Luce made her home in Bishop, California with her daughter Mrs. James L. Butler, wife of the discoverer of Tonopah. After Mrs. Butler's death 3 years ago she made her home in Smokey Valley. She was buried in Belmont Cemetery on 31 Aug 1925.
