Goldfield, NV - Charles McAllister, who has been in charge of the Alkali Springs sub station for Nevada-California Power Company for the last five years, died in Tonopah Wednesday (10 Oct 1934). Mr. McAllister has been ailing for several months but at no time was his condition considered serious. He, in company with his wife, left for Reno Monday, October 1, for medical attention and returned to their home in Alkali Springs last Saturday. Tuesday he became very ill and was taken to the hospital in Tonopah where he died the next day.

He had lived in Esmeralda County for fifteen years coming here from Arizona. He was fifty years of age and a native of Nebraska. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Etta McAllister, and a sister in Prescott, Arizona. He was a member of the Knights of Pythias and the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen"
