David Welsh, forty-four year old timberman at the Black Mammoth mine in Silver Peak, came to an "accidental death caused by a slab of rock cave-in" according to the verdict of a coroner's jury of N. L. Schade, W. A. Hughes and Warren Draper here Wednesday. The coroner's jury verdict was issued following an inquest held before Coroner Walter Bowler.

Welsh died here Wednesday morning of injuries received in the mine accident and funeral services were held yesterday from the Masonic nall.
